Founded in 1976 by actors Jeff Perry, Terry Kinney, and Gary Sinise, Steppenwolf Theatre Company is one of the nation's premier cultural institutions known for its world-renowned ensemble of 49 actors, directors, and playwrights. Groundbreaking productions from *Balm in Gilead* and *August: Osage County* to *Downstate* and *Pass Over* – and accolades that include the National Medal of Arts and 12 Tony® Awards – have made the theater legendary. Deeply rooted in its ensemble ethos, the company is committed to equity, diversity, inclusion and making the Steppenwolf experience accessible to all.

### MISSION

Steppenwolf Theatre Company strives to create thrilling, courageous, and provocative art in a thoughtful and inclusive environment. ### CAMPUS EXPANSION

Designed by world-renowned architect Gordon Gill of Adrian Smith + Gordon Gill Architecture (AS+GG) with theater design and acoustics by Charcoalblue, the transformed Steppenwolf campus will change the way Chicagoans and visitors experience the company's cutting-edge theater. Steppenwolf's new facility is a 50,000 sq. ft building featuring an innovative 400-seat Round Theater only six rows deep; a dedicated education floor doubling the reach and impact of Steppenwolf's nationally recognized education work; and a bright and open two-story atrium lobby, a wine bar, and a sidewalk lounge, increasing the social gathering spaces where artists and audiences converge.

### STEPPENWOLF EDUCATION

Steppenwolf Education celebrates the learner, maker, and appreciator in each of us. Reaching over 20,000 teens, educators, early-career professionals and community members annually, Steppenwolf Education consists of in-school programs, teen programs, educator training, a professional leadership program, and Steppenwolf for Young Adults, the cornerstone of our education programming.

The nationally recognized Steppenwolf for Young Adults performance series brings high-quality theatre to artistically curious young adults across Chicago.
